**Rehabilitation Project**  
(Griffing Avenue to Larchmere Boulevard)

14201 Southington (corner of Ludlow & Southington), Shaker Heights 44120

**What:** Join us for a discussion of the modifications made to the design features at each of the five intersections (Livingston, Ashwood, Buckeye, Hampton & Drexmore) that were made in response to the community's input. At this open-house event, you will have an opportunity to preview and discuss these changes and other aspects of the project. **Construction is scheduled to begin in Spring 2023 and to be completed by Spring 2024.**

The proposed improvements include:

- Full and partial depth pavement repairs as needed, and complete asphalt resurfacing
- New curbs, sidewalk, ADA-compliant curb ramps, and drive aprons, as necessary
- Water main replacement
- Intersection safety improvements
- New signs and pavement markings that include one traffic lane, turn lanes, on-street parking, bike lanes, and shared lanes

**Estimated Cost:** \$7 million

**Funding Sources:** Ohio Public Works; Utilities; City Road & Bridge Bonds

**Construction:** Spring 2023
